Celebrating the 145th Anniversary of the Library

Tuesday, December 7th from 2pm to 6pm

Join us in celebrating our 145th Anniversary! We will be celebrating with snacks and treats at an Open House. Due to the ongoing pandemic, we will not be providing entertainment this year. However, we would love to see you in the Library, see our holiday décor and take a small gift with you.

The first library group started as a reading room only in 1876. They met at the Cordova Baptist Church and voted to set up the Free Library and Reading Room with a voluntary group to support and manage it. The supporters paid 25 cents quarterly to support the library. Soon they realized they needed more money to operate a library. In April of 1878, voters approved a one mill tax on township property and the library has grown ever since.
