Cordova Library Summer Learning Challenge May 31st-July 16th

Our Summer Learning Challenge is almost here! This year, we have a full calendar of programs for kids ages 0-18 to participate in.

To complete the program, kids must read and participate in programs. This isn't just a reading challenge—participating in programs will also earn points toward the total. Once the participant reaches 1,000 points, they earn a trip to an amusement park. During the mid-point check in, kids will vote on going to either Adventureland or Great America. Younger kids finishing the program will be invited to a pool party with their family.


Saturday, July 9th Theme: 1970's Peace & Love
