# February 7<sup>th</sup> The Rosie Project by Graeme Simsion

"The art of love is never a science: Meet Don Tillman, a brilliant yet socially inept professor of genetics, who's decided it's time he found a wife. He designs *The Wife Project* to find his perfect partner: a sixteen-page, scientifically valid survey to filter out the drinkers, the smokers, the late arrivers.

### Surface Design with Cheryl Tuesday January 24, 2023 9:00-12:00

Join us for a morning of Snow/Ice Dyeing. The library will supply the ice (if we have no snow!) and a mask to wear while using the dry powdered dye. Bring: natural fiber fabric (cotton, linen, rayon) and containers to hold the fabric and ice. Containers can be: vases, ice cream buckets, large mason jars, and colanders set inside a small tote. The container just needs to be big enough to hold the fabric and a couple layers of ice. This is always a fun workshop, so be sure to sign up early.

### Tuesday February 21, 2023 9:00-12:00

Learn a new technique! During this workshop we will learn to marble fabric using shaving cream and fabric dyes. Bring: natural fiber fabric (cotton, linen, rayon), approximately 10" x 10". We may get a little messy - an apron is optional, but a good idea!
