During the next two months, Cordova Township, Cordova Fire Department, River Cities Rotary, Toppert Jetting Services and Cordova Baptist Church will be providing the lunches.

Cordova Library is the distribution spot for handing out lunches to Cordova kids. All Cordova kids ages 2-18 will be eligible to receive lunches. Lunches will be distributed at the Library on Mondays & Wednesdays at Noon now through August 9th.


Science of Fire-Rescheduled Tuesday, July 11th
