10 Things You Can Do at the Library (That Aren't Checking Out Books!)

Research your family history. Curious about your roots? Use our free access to *Ancestry.com* to start building your family tree. For the best experience, call ahead to schedule a one-on-one appointment.

Buy stamps. Post office closed? We sell both individual stamps and full books at the same price as the post office.

Get something notarized - for free. Need a document notarized? We've got four notaries on staff. Just call ahead to confirm one is available that day—and remember, don't sign your document until you're in front of the notary!

Create art in our DIY Area. Let your creativity loose in our Do-It-Yourself Area, open whenever the library is. We've stocked it with supplies so you can draw, paint, and craft to your heart's content.

Use our multi-function printer. Print, scan, copy, or fax—our printer does it all. You can even print straight from your phone or send a scan to an email address! Scanning and faxing are free; printing costs just 10¢ for black & white and 25¢ for color.

Borrow a pass to a local attraction. Enjoy a day at the *Niabi Zoo*, *Putnam Museum*, *Quad City Botanical Center*, or *Figge Art Museum*—for free! Passes are for Cordova Library patrons, loaned for 3 days, first-come, first-served (sorry, no reservations).

Use free Wifi or borrow a hotspot. Stay connected with 24/7 Wi-Fi access from our parking lot, or take the internet with you by borrowing a hotspot. Hotspots are for Cordova Library patrons.

Work on a puzzle. Need a brain break? Add a few pieces to our always-in-progress community puzzle. Be warned—it's strangely addictive!

View original art. Take in the beauty of our 78-foot mural, a quilt by our local quilting group, and collaborative pieces created by local kids. There's art to enjoy around every corner.

Attend a program. We host events for all ages! Past programs include: stained glass art, bingo nights, fabric dyeing, musical performances, local history talks, book clubs, wreath and card making, quilting, crochet, and even science experiments.
